1. **Quorum Call:** Brian Scroggin, GLNA President, called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

2. **Review of the Minutes:** The group read the minutes from the January 19, 2017 meeting. Dennis made a motion to approve the minutes. Daron seconded the motion. The motion passed.
3. **Financial Report:** Daron handed out the Financial Report. Below is a summary of the report.

4. **Crime Report:** Brian said that he checked the crime report and there was no new information to report.
5. **Ongoing Business:**

**GLNA Long-Term Plan:** Brian said that he has not yet checked with Rosie Stockdale, our Mayor's Representative, regarding her suggestion that GLNA look into developing a Long-Term Plan in connection with the Indianapolis Neighborhood Resource Center. He will check on that before our March meeting.

**Weekend Clean-up in April:** The group agreed that we should go ahead and schedule a clean-up time. Brian suggested that we check into the cost of getting a dumpster for a few days for the neighborhood to get rid of things that are too large for the weekly trash. The group had some reservations around the cost and the location of the dumpster. Brian said that he will get more information and we can decide on the dumpster at our March meeting. The suggested dates for the clean-up are April 29 – 30.

**Paid Advertising for Newsletter:** Brian said that Mandy Johnson has volunteered to help with the newsletter. It was suggested that Brian put out a request on Facebook for articles for the next newsletter.

**Meijer:** Brian reported that he stopped at Meijer to introduce himself and request that Meijer keep up their property along 96<sup>th</sup> and Village Way. Brian said that the current

manager is moving to a new store so we will need to visit again when the new manager arrives.

**6. New Business:**

**New Neighborhood Greeting and Welcome Baskets:** Andrea is coordinating the effort to welcome all new residents in GLNA. She said that she and Brian had delivered information to a new resident on Champton. She suggested that we give a wooden “Welcome” plaque along with the GLNA information. She said that each plaque would cost \$10.00 and that her daughter could make them. The group liked and agreed with this suggestion. Linda volunteered to help.

**Sidewalk Repair:** Barbara Schauland had sent Brian a list of 10 sidewalks that need repairs. In discussing this issue, Daron was not in favor of spending any GLNA money to do the repairs because we do not have a big enough budget to do all of the work and therefore we would have to prioritize what got done. This potentially would make some residents angry with GLNA if their sidewalk was not the one being repaired. Brian said he had contacted Hunter’s Ridge about their sidewalk repairs and disabled accessible corners. His contact said that the city had paid for the work. Brian will check with Rosie Stockdale and/or Mike McQuillen to find out the process for getting the city to pay for the repairs.

**Garage Sale:** It was suggested that the Garage Sale be the first weekend in June. Eli suggested that we have the sale on Saturday, June 3 and Sunday, June 4 rather than Friday and Saturday. The group was open to that change. We traditionally join with Hunter’s Ridge and Pine Ridge on the dates. This way we only need to pay for an ad in the Indy Star every 3 years. Brian will check with the other 2 neighborhoods to see if those dates work for them. It is GLNA’s turn to pay for the ad.
